

RoHS Compliance — Feb. 2010 Update

This summary provides the status of compliance with the RoHS Directive and associated activities for HydraForce, Inc.

What are the RoHS Directives?

RoHS stands for the Restriction of Hazardous Substances. There are two specific European Union Directives that restrict the use of the following materials on specific products placed on its internal market.

Substances banned or severely restricted include:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBBs)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE's)

HydraForce's Commitment

Directive No. 2002/95/EC

As of the July 1, 2006, the effectivity date of the RoHS Directive No. 2002/95/EC, HydraForce is 100% compliant in relation to all our electronics products. This includes all cataloged and non-cataloged valve drivers, machine controllers, and any peripheral electronics products used in full system and machine controls.

Directive No.2000/53/EC

As of January 1, 2008, all of HydraForce's standard hydraulic valves, components, and solenoids are 100% in compliance with the RoHS Directives. Directive No. 2000/53/EC bans or severely restricts the above list of hazardous materials from being used in heavy metal components used on vehicles. This directive assures that vehicles and end-of-life vehicles to be compliant with RoHS.
